To vote against a question, fill in the oval next to the word "No" on that question.</div> <div>County Question 1</div> <div>LOCAL OPTION SALES AND USE TAX FOR FUNDING NEW JAIL</div> <div>Shall Winona County be authorized to impose a sales and use tax of one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) to fund the design, construction, and related costs for the newly built Winona County Jail that replaced the old jail built in 1970?</div> <div>If approved, collections from the sales tax would replace property tax as the source for repayment of the \$28 million in bonds issued for the new jail, plus interest and bond issuance costs.
